## Volunteer Descriptions

### 2018 – 2019

#### **Advent Fest Helper**

2 hour commitment. Help younger children with crafts and cookie decorating or help in the kitchen for soup supper. Opportunity to help “dress up the church” for Advent/Christmas season as well.

#### **Assist Confirmation Leader**

60 minute commitment. Monitor & assist with classroom management during large group instruction or mini-break out activities. During small group break-out (last 15 minutes), assist youth with Bible verse memorization, prayer sheets, and other requirements.

#### **Assist Connect Leader**

60 minute commitment. Assist with set-up for lesson or activity while kids are in music room. Monitor & assist with classroom management during large group instruction or mini-break out activities. Help keep youth actively engaged in class.

#### **Assist Miss Libby with Connect**

30 minute commitment. Help with last minute set-up of instruments, music, chairs, etc. As Miss Libby is instructing, offer help to kids as needed or join in to help demonstrate. Connect meets with Miss Libby the first 15 minutes of class from 6:30 - 6:45 PM.

#### **Butterbraid Distribution**

35 minute commitment. Butterbraid’s are a frozen pastry fundraiser that we do each fall. Butterbraid orders will already be separated by individuals. Help is needed with handing out to parishioners who ordered. Simply stand in kitchen, give individuals their order, & mark off on sheet as picked up.

#### **Christmas Program Rehearsal Helper**

90 minute commitment. Miss Libby will lead music rehearsal, but needs assistance with gathering children together and keeping them on task. Sometimes the helper may be asked to work on speaking parts with a small group or individuals. In addition, helpers may set-up a snack for kids while they are singing.

#### **Christmas Program Seating Set-up**

75 minute commitment. Set-up chairs in gym for Children’s Christmas Program. Scheduled time is to set-up Saturday, Dec. 8 from 4:00-5:15 PM, but could be done after noon or after Saturday worship. Team of 3-4 people can set the time that works best.

#### **Confirmation Brunch Kitchen Help**

2.5 hour commitment. Prepare egg bakes and side items, set-up tables for dining, make coffee, serve food and assist with clean-up. All food items provided by church. Confirmation students & their families enjoy a warm brunch followed by youth sharing their faith statements as well as professional photographs in the sanctuary.

## **Dine in Unity Meal Volunteers**

**Regular Weeks:** Individuals, pairs, or a group of people may sign up to prepare, serve & clean-up Wednesday night meals. Arrive in time to get everything prepared & ready for serving times which run from 5:45 - 6:25 PM.

**Advent, Ash Wednesday & Lent Weeks:** The main course of soup is provided by Bill Walker each week. Individuals, pairs, or a group of people may sign up to prepare a side dish and dessert and will also assist with serving & clean-up of the meals. Serving times run from 5:00 - 5:55 PM for Advent & Lent, but Ash Wednesday runs from 5:15 - 6:25 PM.

## **Kids Cave Monitor**

60 minute commitment. Kids Cave is an activity room for children who do not have a class on Wednesday, but a parent and/or sibling are here for a class. Kids Cave has board games, Legos, puzzles, coloring books, a NEW wall chalk board, Wii gaming system, & DVD player. The monitor is responsible for monitoring and engaging the kids in safe play during the hour.

## **Kitchen Help for Caroling Potluck**

90 min commitment. Help in kitchen by organizing potluck items, preparing coffee and drinks, serving food, clean-up & empty garbage outside. Volunteers may need to depart caroling a little early to get set-up for the hungry crew.

## **Kitchen Help for Christmas Program**

90 min+ commitment. Assist in kitchen for Children's Christmas Program by organizing cookies & bars on trays, making coffee, preparing kid friendly drinks, serving & clean-up after the show.

## **PAL: Parents as Leaders Guide**

90 minute commitment. Basic lesson plans are provided, but will require approx. 30 minutes of prep before class in addition to 60 minute class time. PAL Sunday runs twice a year offering parents the opportunity to lead SPARK class while our regular classroom teachers attend an in-service training on-site. Typically, each grade level attends music & Bible lesson rotation, but then gathers for a combined large group activity. FUN weekend for parents & kids!

## **Saturday SPARK Helper**

60 minute commitment. Assist SPARK Leader with set-up for lesson or activity. Participate in music time with Miss Libby to help kids get engaged and sing along. Monitor & assist children who need help during lesson and activity time.

## **SPARK Helper (PK-K, 1st-2nd & 3rd-4th)**

60 minute commitment. Assist SPARK Leader with set-up for lesson or activity. Participate in music time with Miss Libby to help kids get engaged and sing along. Monitor & assist children who need help during lesson and activity time.

## **Thanksgiving Eve Pie Social**

60 minute commitment. Following Thanksgiving Eve worship, help is needed in the kitchen to serve pie, prepare & serve coffee and other drinks, as well as clean-up.
