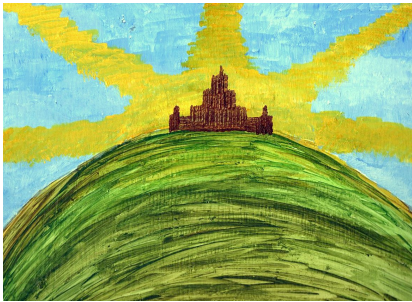

Dear Partners in the Gospel,

Light is used in so many ways. Light shows the way. It searches and exposes. It can heal. It is a companion for those who are fearful and a threat to those who intend evil.

We go camping in the summer and a flashlight shows us the paths to follow at night. On winter evenings I walk down the streets of Fond du Lac and streetlights help us find our way through the darkness.

Light shows the dust on our table tops in our houses. Even our vacuum cleaner comes with a headlight so we can see the debris and dust on the carpet. Laser beams are used for so many surgical procedures today, and light is known to be a factor in helping some avoid or overcome depression. And of course for the child afraid of the dark, a night-light is a great comfort.

During this season of Epiphany, where the Christ is continually being revealed to us as the light in darkness, it becomes apparent that Jesus performs all these functions too. To follow him is to find abundant life. To be open to him is to allow our sins to be exposed. When our sins are acknowledged, we can be healed through God's forgiveness and comforted by Jesus' presence.

Thank you, Jesus, for coming into our lives to push back the darkness and to bring light!

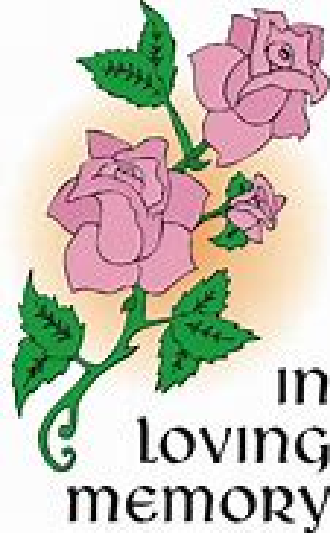
